**To: Shipping Agents and Representatives, Ship Masters, Shipowners and Others**

**Subject: Implementation of Maharani Freeport – Activities Within the Waters of Muar Port Limits**

Please be informed that the waters within Muar Port limits together with the MEG Tanjung Emas Complex have been designated as part of Maharani Freeport under the Free Zone Act 1990, effective from 28 November 2025 (refer to the official Government Gazettes P.U.(B) 418/2025 and P.U.(B) 420/2025).

Maharani Freeport Sdn Bhd has been appointed as the Maharani Freeport Authority, who is responsible to administer, maintain and operate Maharani Freeport. The Maharani Freeport Authority shall also have oversight on safety and security matters within the whole of Maharani Freeport areas.

The Jetty of Maharani Freeport Free Commercial Zone (MEG Tanjung Emas Complex) has also been approved by the Royal Customs Department as Legal Landing Place (P.U.(A) 87/2026).

In view of the above, all activities within the Maharani Freeport shall be undertaken in accordance with the Free Zone Act 1990 and its regulations and shall be with the approval of the Maharani Freeport Authority.

Generally –

1. Every movement of personnel, goods, vehicle and vessel shall be reported to the Freeport Authority. All vessels entering Muar Port limit shall abide by the guidelines issued by Port Operator.
2. All goods traded in Maharani Freeport shall be reported using the proper Free Zone (ZB1 form) and Customs (K1) forms. This will include break bulking of cargo and ship to ship transfer of cargo and supply of provisions to vessels within Muar Port.
3. All vessels arriving and departing Muar Port shall report to the appropriate Government agencies and the Freeport Authority. All vessels shall comply with the port arrival procedures. All vessels shall also report to Maharani Terminal Control Centre. Vessels shall only anchor at the designated Anchorage Area within Muar Port.
4. Any activity that passes through the Main Gate at MEG Complex Tanjung Emas shall be with the approval of the Freeport Authority.

5. All vendors, service providers, contractors, traders and others operating within Maharani Freeport shall be approved and properly registered with the Freeport Authority. This includes all existing parties already providing services within Maharani Freeport. For the registration process, parties are to be referred to MEG OSC Sdn Bhd. 6. Any supply of goods, provisions and services to vessels within Muar Port limit shall only be conducted through MEG Complex Tanjung Emas and in accordance with the applicable rules and regulations.

In relation to the above, all activities and services provided within Maharani Freeport shall be subject to the approved fees and charges. These include vessels entering and anchoring within Muar Port limits, movement of goods and personnel through the Freeport areas.

Please be further informed that service providers or companies that are not registered with Maharani Freeport will not be allowed access to deliver the services. In this case, vessels may instead arrange supplies and services from companies already registered.
